Explanation of Responses:

- Represents restricted stock units awarded as a supplemental retirement benefit that vest and are payable solely in shares of common stock of the Company on the day following the retirement of the Reporting Person; provided that such retirement occurs after the latest to occur of (i) the date the Recipient attains age sixty (60); (ii) the end of the five (5) year period beginning on the date the Reporting Person is hired by the Company; or (iii) the end of the one (1) year period beginning on the date of this award. Restricted stock units also vest and are payable in shares of common stock of the Company upon the death or disability of the Reporting Person or if the Reporting Person's employment with the Company is terminated without cause. Finally, restricted stock units vest and are payable upon the occurrence of a change in control, in cash or in shares of common stock of the Company, whichever is specified by the Committee administering the Plan.
- Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company, on January 2, 2013 and on each January 2nd thereafter through January 2, 2017.
- Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company on each anniversary of the January 3, 2012 award date.
- Represents an option to purchase shares of common stock of the Company awarded to the Reporting Person pursuant to the Company's 2005 Equity Incentive Plan.
- Options to purchase shares of common stock of the Company awarded to the Reporting Person pursuant to the Company's 2005 Equity Incentive Plan expired by their terms without being exercised by the Reporting Person.
- Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total number of options granted vest and become exercisable on each anniversary grant date.
- Represents Performance Units which will be awarded to the Reporting Person under the Company's Equity Stock Incentive Plan upon achievement of the targeted return on invested capital for 2013. The maximum number of Performance Units which may be earned is two hundred percent (200%) of the Performance Units awarded for target level performance and the minimum number of Performance Units which may be earned is zero (0) Performance Units.
- Performance Units vest and are paid at the end of the three (3) consecutive calendar year period ending December 31, 2015 or, if earlier, upon death, disability or retirement. Performance Units are forfeited if employment is terminated before December 31, 2015 for reasons other than death, disability or retirement or by the Company without cause. Performance Units are payable solely in cash in an amount equal to the ninety (90) day trailing average price of one (1) share of the Company's common stock determined as of December 31, 2015 or, if applicable, death, disability or retirement.
- Represents Performance Units which will be awarded to the Reporting Person under the Company's Equity Incentive Plan upon achievement of the targeted return on invested capital for 2015. The maximum number of Performance Units which may be earned is two hundred percent (200%) of the Performance Units awarded for target level performance and the minimum number of Performance Units which may be earned is zero (0) Performance Units.
- Performance Units vest and are paid at the end of three (3) consecutive calendar year periods ending December 31, 2017 or, if earlier, upon death, disability or retirement. Performance Units are forfeited if employment is terminated before December 31, 2017 for reasons other than death, disability or retirement or by the Company without cause. Performance Units are payable solely in cash in an amount equal to the ninety (90) day trailing average price of one (1) share of the Company's common stock determined as of December 31, 2017, or if applicable, death, disability or retirement.
- Represents matching restricted stock units allocated to the Reporting Person after 2012 with respect to the Reporting Person's deferral of a portion of his base salary pursuant to the Company's Management Stock Purchase Plan.
- Restricted stock units are forfeited if Reporting Person's service as an officer of the Company is terminated prior to age sixty (60). If service as an officer continues through age sixty (60), restricted stock units are payable solely in cash in one lump sum payment or in five (5) or ten (10) consecutive, substantially equal annual installments, whichever distribution form is elected by the Reporting Person, beginning six (6) months following termination of service. Each restricted stock unit is converted to cash in an amount equal to the fair market value (200 day rolling average) of one share of the Company's common stock on the date of termination of the Reporting Person's service as an officer of the Company.
- Represents restricted stock units allocated pursuant to the Company's Management Stock Purchase Plan to match restricted stock units allocated through deferral by Reporting Person of a portion of his annual incentive compensation award.
- Matching restricted stock units are forfeited if employment is terminated prior to age sixty (60). If employment continues through age sixty (60), restricted stock units are payable solely in cash in five (5) consecutive, substantially equal annual installments beginning the first January 1 occurring six (6) months following termination of employment. Each restricted stock unit is converted to cash in an amount equal to the fair market value (200 day rolling average) of one share of the Company's common stock on the date the Reporting Person's employment is terminated.
- Represents restricted stock units allocated to the Reporting Person after 2012 with respect to the Reporting Person's deferral of a portion of his base salary pursuant to the Company's Management Stock Purchase Plan.
- Restricted stock units are payable solely in cash in one lump sum payment or in five (5) or ten (10) consecutive, substantially equal annual installments, whichever distribution form is elected by the Reporting Person, beginning six (6) months following termination of service as an officer of the Company. Each restricted stock unit is converted to cash in an amount equal to the fair market value (200 day rolling average) of one share of the Company's common stock on the date of termination of the Reporting Person's service as an officer of the Company.
- Represents restricted stock units allocated pursuant to the Company's Management Stock Purchase Plan funded by the deferral of receipt by Reporting Person of a portion of his annual incentive compensation award.
- Restricted stock units are forfeited if employment is terminated prior to age sixty (60). If employment continues through age sixty (60), restricted stock units are payable solely in cash in five (5) consecutive, substantially equal annual installments beginning the first January 1 occurring six (6) months following termination of employment. Each restricted stock unit is converted to cash in an amount equal to the fair market value (200 day rolling average) of one share of the Company's common stock on the date the Reporting Person's employment is terminated.
